FOCUS	Point solutions	Enabling conditions
ASSETS USED	Single asset class (e.g. venture equity, microlending)	Cross asset class, including philanthropy
PORTFOLIO CONSTRUCTION	Portfolios used as a mechanism of diversification	Portfolios used to enhance value through synergy
STAKEHOLDER INPUT	Focus on beneficiaries and customers for solutions	Drawing on full stakeholder network that enables and constrains solutions










#### **Just Transition Finance Report**










#### 1980s-1990s - COMMUNITY PROTEST & INACTION









### Community villagers, including women and farmers, breaching an earthen embakme

with spades and bamboo poles. Tidal water rushing ifito a floodplain. Green shoots emerging from newly deposited silt. Faces of cautious hope and relief

In 1997, people in Beel Bhaina breached the embankment themselves. Tidal water reentered; the beel began to heal. Agriculture and ecology revived.

Tidal River Management (TRM) was born -- from the people, not planners

#### 2000-2001 - Formation of Paani Committee

With Uttaran's support, the Paani Committee was formed.
A decentralized civil platform led by those most affected.
Represented the grassroots voice for river justice






